

The primary objective of the scheme is to replace traditional cooking fuels such as firewood and cow dung with liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), thereby improving the health and well-being of women and children who are often exposed to harmful fumes from traditional cooking methods.



Under the scheme, eligible beneficiaries are provided with a financial assistance of Rs. 1,600 to cover the cost of the security deposit for the cylinder and pressure regulator, installation charges, administrative charges, safety hose, and other accessories.

Throughout the session, emphasis is placed on proper alignment, mindful breathing, and listening to the body's cues. Participants are encouraged to practice at their own pace, honoring their limitations while gradually progressing in their practice.

- **Twists and Backbends:** Asanas like Ardha Matsyendrasana (Half Lord of the Fishes Pose) and Bhujangasana (Cobra Pose) help in improving spinal flexibility and strengthening the back muscles.


